The Eastern and Southern Africa Small-scale Farmer's Forum (ESAFF) in Zambia aims at creating a dynamic national movement of small scale farmers for collective voice and action in promoting equitable access to and control or resources for seed, food and income security and sustainable development through policy analysis, lobbying, advocacy and information sharing. In addition, ESAFF aims at seeing Small-Scale Farmers practicing sustainable agriculture for sustainable development in equitable environment of supportive policies and practices that enables them to access, control, manage and benefit from necessary resources.
